ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus seeking an order directing the Board of Parole Commissioners to place petitioner on the next parole board agenda. Petitioner argues that he is entitled to be placed on the next parole board agenda because he should receive the benefit of the 1995 amendments decreasing the penalties for NRS 453.3385. We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time.<sup>1</sup>
