## ORDER DISMISSING APPEALS

These are appeals from judgments of conviction, upon pleas of guilty, of trafficking in a controlled substance and battery by a prisoner.<sup>1</sup> The State has moved to dismiss the appeals on the ground that as part of the plea agreements in these cases, appellant waived his right to appeal. The written guilty plea agreements that appellant signed and that were filed in the proceedings below clearly and unequivocally provide that
