

ORDER OF REVERSAL AND REMAND CLF



This is an appeal from a district court judgment awarding contract damages. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Michael L. Douglas, Judge.

This is appellant Kerala Properties, Inc.'s third appeal to this court. In the second appeal, we reversed the district court's judgment granting respondent, Bruce Familian, specific performance, and remanded the matter for another trial restricted to Familian's claim for damages. More particularly, we stated:

The measure of damages should include Familian's losses in reliance on the contract, such as expenses incurred in the bid process and escrow expenses. Additionally, Familian may recover attorney's fees, as provided by the contract, and prejudgment interest as authorized by statute.

Based on the evidence presented at an evidentiary hearing, the district court awarded damages as follows:

\$ 78,795.91 - property development expenses

183,449.75 - attorney's fees

1,838.13 - court costs

335,047.96 - loss based on property value increase

49,045.85 - prejudgment interest

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Because we rejected specific performance as a remedy, and because we limited the scope of recoverable damages, the district court's damage award violated our second order of remand. That order in effect rendered the contract unenforceable and eliminated property valuation and projected costs of improvements as issues in the case. Accordingly, we reverse and remand this matter for entry of judgment in the amount of \$264,083.79, plus prejudgment interest based upon that principal amount.¹

Therefore, we

ORDER the judgment of the district court REVERSED AND REMAND this matter to the district court for proceedings consistent with this order.
