

This is an appeal from an order revoking appellant's probation and an amended judgment of conviction. Attorney Diane L. Kappenman, counsel for appellant in the revocation proceedings below,¹ has filed a motion to withdraw this appeal voluntarily. In the motion, counsel advises that she has informed appellant of the legal effects and consequences of voluntarily withdrawing this appeal, including that appellant cannot hereafter seek to reinstate this appeal, and that any issues that were or could have been brought in this appeal are forever


¹We grant the motion filed by attorney Andrew S. Fritz to withdraw as counsel in this appeal. We note that the order and amended judgment appealed from incorrectly lists Mr. Fritz as having represented appellant during the revocation proceedings. In fact, prior to the revocation proceedings, the district court permitted Mr. Fritz to withdraw as counsel; appellant was thereafter represented during the proceedings at issue by attorney Kappenman. Accordingly, we direct the district court to enter a corrected order and judgment accurately reflecting that attorney Diane Kappenman represented appellant during the revocation proceedings below. See NRS 176.565 (clerical errors in judgments or orders may be corrected by the court at any time).
