ORDER OF TRANSFER TO DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS


Bar Counsel for the State Bar of Nevada and attorney Robert V. Bogan have jointly petitioned this court for an order transferring Bogan to disability inactive status. The parties have stipulated that Bogan is presently incapacitated under the terms of SCR 117 from continuing to practice law.

Having reviewed the petition and its attachments, we conclude that the relief requested in the joint petition is warranted under the circumstances. Accordingly, Robert V. Bogan is transferred to disability inactive status. Bogan may resume the active practice of law only after he has complied with SCR 117(6) and (7), and after he has reimbursed the client security fund for any amounts paid to his former clients on his behalf.¹

¹The joint petition also requires that Bogan satisfy any sanctions imposed by this court. We note that no sanctions are currently outstanding, and so this requirement is moot.


The State Bar shall effect notice of this order as required under SCR 117(4) and (5). Bar counsel shall provide this court with proof that notice has been served.


It is so ORDERED.




