ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL AND
DIRECTING PAYMENT OF FILING FEE

On May 16, 2003, respondents filed a motion to dismiss this appeal for lack of jurisdiction. Respondents argue that this appeal was not timely filed and therefore this court lacks jurisdiction to entertain the appeal. We note that although this court granted appellants an extension of time until August 11, 2003, to file an opposition to respondents' motion, to date, appellants have not opposed the motion.

Appellants' notice of appeal indicates that appellants are appealing from a "Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Judgment" filed in the district court on March 3, 2003. The notice of entry of the judgment was served on appellants by mail on March 13, 2003. Accordingly, appellants had until April 15, 2003, to file their notice of appeal. See NRAP 4(a)(1); NRAP 26(c). Appellants did not file their notice of appeal until April 22, 2003. Because it appears that appellants' notice of appeal was untimely filed, we grant respondents' unopposed motion and we dismiss this appeal.

This appeal was docketed in this court on April 25, 2003. Because the notice of appeal was not accompanied by the required filing fee, on April 25, 2003, this court sent appellants a notice directing them to

pay the filing fee within 10 days. See NRAP 3(f); NRS 2.250(1)(a). Because appellants had not yet paid the filing fee, on August 1, 2003, this court entered an order that, among other things, directed appellants to pay the filing fee. To date, appellants have failed to pay the required filing fee. Appellants shall have 10 days from the date of this order to pay the \$200 filing fee. We caution appellants' counsel that failure to comply timely with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions.
