## ORDER ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSING APPEAL.

This is a proper person appeal, apparently from numerous interlocutory rulings of the district court,<sup>1</sup> in a criminal proceeding wherein appellant was convicted of one count of burglary and two counts of robbery with the use of a deadly weapon.<sup>2</sup> The district court filed the written judgment of conviction on March 31, 2003. Appellant filed the instant proper person appeal on April 30, 2003.

Appellant's direct appeal from the judgment of conviction at issue is currently pending before this court in Docket No. 41299. Any claims of error regarding the interlocutory rulings challenged in this proper person appeal should be raised, if at all, by appellant's counsel in the pending direct appeal in Docket No. 41299. Accordingly, because it appears that this appeal was mistakenly docketed in this court as a
