

ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS

JACKIE CRAWFORD, DIRECTOR-NDOC, and CRAIG FARWELL, WARDEN, LOVELOCK CORRECTIONAL CENTER,

Respondents.

On March 26, 2003, Petitioner Jeffrey Paul Morgan, in proper person, filed his Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus in this Court. Petitioner is currently incarcerated at the Lovelock Correctional Center, located in Pershing County, Nevada.

Petitioner states in his Petition that he is not attacking his Judgment of Conviction or his prison sentence that was rendered by the Third Judicial District Court of Nevada. Rather, Petitioner is challenging his conditions of confinement at the Lovelock Correctional Center. Petitioner contends that his 8th Amendment protection against "Cruel and Unusual Punishment" was violated by reasons of use of excessive force by prison officers, unnecessary injury inflicted by prison officers, and negligent medical care.

In a Post-conviction Habeas Corpus action, a prisoner may only challenge the judgment of conviction or sentence in criminal case or the computation of time served pursuant to a conviction. (NRS 34.720). A Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus may challenge the validity but not the conditions of confinement. Bowen v. Warden, 100 Nev. 489, 490, 686 P.2d 250, 250 (1984).

Morgan's Petition does not challenge the validity of the underlying conviction for which he is imprisoned at the Lovelock Correctional Center. Rather, he is challenging the treatment he received by prison personnel after he was allegedly struck by a motorized vehicle while walking on prison property.

As such, Morgan's Petition is not cognizable in a Habeas Corpus proceeding.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, therefore, Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus is HEREBY DISMISSED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Petitioner's Motion for the Appointment of Counsel, Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Request for Injunctive Relief are HEREBY DENIED.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
