ORDER DENYING REINSTATEMENT


In this petition, Jeffrey N. Samuels, who was disbarred in 1992, seeks reinstatement to the practice of law under SCR 116. A hearing panel of the Southern Nevada Disciplinary Board has recommended that the petition be denied, as petitioner has not demonstrated by clear and convincing evidence that he should be reinstated.


Having reviewed the record, we conclude that the hearing panel correctly found that Samuels did not meet his burden to demonstrate by clear and convincing evidence that he has the qualifications to be reinstated.¹ We therefore deny Samuels' petition



without prejudice and order that he bear the costs of his reinstatement hearing, up to his \$750 advance deposit.


It is so ORDERED.²
