This is a proper person appeal from a district court order granting a preliminary injunction. The district court's order prohibits appellant and the other defendants below from recovering personal property and documents from the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department and the Clark County District Attorney's Office. The personal property and documents relate to the underlying district court case. We conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion in granting the preliminary injunction,¹ and accordingly, we

AFFIRM the district court's order.²
