

ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL



This is a proper person appeal from a judgment of conviction. This court's preliminary review of this appeal reveals that the district court entered the judgment of conviction on January 21, 2003. Appellant did not file the notice of appeal, however, until June 13, 2003, well after the expiration of the thirty-day appeal period prescribed by NRAP 4(b). An untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court.<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, we conclude that we lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal, and we
