This is an appeal from an order of the district court dismissing an appeal from the municipal court. This court's review of this appeal reveals a potential jurisdictional defect. Specifically, appellant's case arose in the municipal court. The district court has final appellate jurisdiction over a case arising in the municipal court.¹


On September 17, 2003, this court ordered appellant's counsel to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. On October 7, 2003, counsel filed a response to this court's order, conceding that this court lacks jurisdiction to entertain this appeal. Based on our review of the documents before this court, including
