
ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL AS ABANDONED


This appeal was docketed in this court on October 27, 2003. Accordingly, the docketing statement was due to be filed by November 11, 2003. See NRAP 14(b). On December 1, 2003, respondent filed a motion to dismiss appeal on the grounds that the appeal was jurisdictionally defective. On December 11, 2003, this court entered an order noting that appellants had failed to file the docketing statement and directed appellants to do so by December 21, 2003. That order cautioned appellants that failure to comply with that order may result in the dismissal of this appeal as abandoned.


Because appellants have failed to file the docketing statement, respond to our order entered December 11, 2003, or respond to the motion to dismiss, we dismiss this appeal as abandoned. Further, we deny

respondent's motion to dismiss, as moot, and will take no action with regard to the settlement judge's report filed on December 15, 2003.
