ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR
WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR PROHIBITION

This original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenges a district court order imposing NRCP 11 sanctions upon petitioner. We have considered the petition, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time. In particular, NRAP 21(a) requires a petitioner to provide copies of any parts of the record essential to an understanding of the matters set forth in the petition. Here, petitioner did not provide sufficient

documentation for us to evaluate whether the district court's order was appropriate. Accordingly, we deny the petition.¹
