

## **ORDER DENYING PETITION**

This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner seeks an order directing the district court to conduct an evidentiary hearing on his habeas corpus petition. Alternatively, petitioner seeks an order vacating the order revoking probation. We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time.<sup>1</sup> Petitioner has an adequate remedy to challenge the district court's
