ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL AS ABANDONED

This appeal was docketed in this court on November 17, 2003. Because the notice of appeal was not accompanied by the requisite filing fee or the case appeal statement, on that same date this court issued notices directing appellant to pay the filing fee and to file the case appeal statement within 10 days. See NRAP 3(a)(1); NRAP 3(f).


Because appellant had not yet paid the filing fee or filed the case appeal statement, and also failed to file the docketing statement, on February 9, 2004, this court entered an order directing appellant to file the required documents within 10 days. See NRAP 14(b). That order cautioned appellant that failure to timely comply with the order might result in the imposition of sanctions, including dismissal of this appeal as abandoned.

Because appellant had still not paid the filing fee, filed the case appeal statement or filed the docketing statement, on March 30, 2004, this court entered a second order directing appellant to file the required documents within 10 days. That order again cautioned appellant

that failure to timely comply might result in the imposition of sanctions, including dismissal of this appeal as abandoned.

To date, appellant has failed to pay the filing fee, failed to file the case appeal statement, failed to file the docketing statement, and failed to respond to our previous notices and orders or otherwise communicate with this court. We therefore order this appeal dismissed as abandoned. See NRAP 14(c).
