ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

Kevin Sewell has petitioned for reinstatement to practice law under SCR 116. A Southern Nevada Disciplinary Board hearing panel has recommended that the petition be granted, and we conclude that the panel's recommendation should be approved.<sup>1</sup>

SCR 116(3) requires that a lawyer seeking reinstatement must:

demonstrat[e] by clear and convincing evidence that the attorney has the moral qualifications, competency, and learning in law required for admission to practice law in this state, and that the attorney's resumption of the practice of law will not be detrimental to the integrity and standing of the bar, to the administration of justice, or to the public interest.

Sewell presented testimony from two lawyers with whom he has closely worked, as well as letters from former clients, in support of his petition.

Having reviewed the record, we conclude that clear and convincing evidence supports the panel's findings, and that its recommendation should be approved. Accordingly, Kevin Sewell is hereby reinstated to the practice of law.
