


ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR
WRIT OF MANDAMUS


This is an original petition for a writ of mandamus challenging a district court order that denied petitioners' summary judgment motion in a contract action, and determined that the liability limitation clauses in the parties' contracts were void as against public policy. We have considered this petition, and we are not satisfied that this court's

intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time.¹
Accordingly, we deny the petition.²
