## ORDER OF REMAND

This is a proper person appeal from an order of the district court denving a post-conviction petition for a writ of a habeas corpus. On May 7, 2004, this court entered an order deferring a decision on appellant's motion to dismiss this appeal and requesting the district court to report the status of the proceedings below. On May 19, 2004, the district court filed a responsive order.

Having reviewed the district court's response, we have concluded that a remand for further proceedings on certain claims presented in appellant's petition is warranted. Accordingly, we grant appellant's motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, and we remand this appeal to the district court without prejudice to appellant's right, if aggrieved, to file a timely, separate notice appeal from any forthcoming order of the district court finally resolving appellant's claims.
