7 Court, its staff, counsel or courtroom observers.

8 5. The location of all media photographer(s) is subject to the direction and control of the
9 clerk of the Court. Absent good cause, media cameras must be located in the back row of the
10 Courtroom and photographers must remain seated during filming.

11 6. All media cameras are subject to inspection at all times by the clerk of the Court.

12 7. All photographers must sign a copy of this Order prior to bringing any media camera
13 into the Courtroom. Non-media cameras are not permitted in Court at any time.

14 8. Film, videotape, photography and audio reproductions of this proceeding may not be
15 used for unrelated advertising purposes.
