**GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR,**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that electronic video and/or audio equipment may be used at proceedings in this department, unless an objection is timely filed by any party to a matter then pending, in which case the objection would be set for hearing and decision.

Rules for use of media equipment are as follows:

1. There will be no artificial lighting devices allowed in Court. If any media camera has an illumination device as an integral component of the camera, the light(s) on the camera shall be disconnected and proof shown to the clerk of the Court before such camera will be permitted into the Courtroom.

2. Only one (1) still media camera and only one (1) video/motion picture media camera may be used during any Court session. If there are cameras that would exceed this number,

1 media representatives shall select one (1) still photographer and one (1) video/motion picture  
2 photographer to act as "pool" photographers. If the representatives cannot agree, then the  
3 default still photographer and video/motion picture photographer will be at the court's  
4 discretion.

5 3. All Pool photographers are ordered to immediately share their work product.

6 4. No media camera may be operated in such a fashion as to create a disturbance to the  
7 Court, its staff, counsel or courtroom observers.

8 5. The location of all media photographer(s) is subject to the direction and control of the  
9 clerk of the Court. Absent good cause, media cameras must be located in the back row of the  
10 Courtroom and photographers must remain seated during filming.

11 6. All media cameras are subject to inspection at all times by the clerk of the Court.

12 7. All photographers must sign a copy of this Order prior to bringing any media camera  
13 into the Courtroom. Non-media cameras are not permitted in Court at any time.

14  
15 8. Film, videotape, photography and audio reproductions of this proceeding may not be  
16 used for unrelated advertising purposes.

17 9. The clerk is directed to provide a copy of this order to all attorneys, all parties and to  
18 the media pool coordinator or his designee. It shall be the responsibility of attorneys to notify  
19 their witnesses of this order.
