



ORDER

Our Nevada Judges has submitted a request seeking access to the Court of Appeals of Nevada oral argument in the above entitled matter for the purpose of photographic or electronic coverage of the hearing to be held March 29, 2022, beginning at 11:00 a.m. This oral argument may be viewed on the Nevada Supreme Court's website at www.nvcourts.gov/supreme.

To the extent the request seeks permission to record the proceedings via the court's live stream through YouTube, it is unnecessary to seek permission from this court to do so as this is publicly available information, therefore it is granted. To the extent the request seeks to photograph or record within the courtroom, it is granted, although we note that the attorneys will be appearing remotely and the judges of this court may appear in the Las Vegas courtroom, the Caron City courtroom, or from a remote location.¹ Accordingly,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission is granted for photographic or electronic media coverage of the court proceedings, for news purposes and not for commercial exploitation;

¹This order does not waive the requirements set forth in SCR 229 through 246 for future requests for media access to court proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all persons participating in such photographic or electronic coverage shall observe the standards set forth in the Supreme Court Rules in all respects, and Alexander Falconi of Our Nevada Judges is designated as pool coordinator for purposes of organizing and coordinating the orderly coverage of such proceedings by all participants.

All equipment necessary to allow for such photographic or electronic coverage of such proceedings shall be in place 10 minutes prior to the start of argument.

It is so ORDERED.
