Good morning, Mr. Falconi and Mr. Margiott. Judge Steinheimer has given permission for electronic media coverage of the hearing in CV22-00560, *In re: Jenny Brekhus*, that is scheduled to occur on April 20, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. Both of your outlets have submitted requests for coverage. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 233, only one still camera and one video camera will be permitted in the court room at any given time, and that camera must serve as the pool camera for other outlets. Please coordinate between yourselves which outlet will serve as the pool video camera.

Please ensure the videographer arrives at least fifteen minutes prior to scheduled court proceeding and remains throughout the hearing or until there is a natural break in the hearing. Upon arrival, the court room bailiff will direct the videographer to an appropriate filming location. A complete list of the rules governing electronic media coverage can be found at Attending Court - Washoecourts. Please note that Department 4 does not allow shorts, sweats, tank tops or flip flops.
