16	ORDER REGARDING COURTROOM DECORUM DURING TRIAL
17	Trial in the above-referenced matters is set to begin January 22, 2024.
18	In order to maintain the proper decorum of these proceedings and to ensure a
19	fair trial to both defendants and the government, the Court hereby orders and directs
20	that all parties in this case and all spectators in the courtroom shall abide by the
	following:
21	(1) Based on security concerns expressed by the Washoe County Sheriff's Office
22	related to the instant case, and pursuant to the Administrative Order entered on
23	June 28, 2007, wireless communications devices must remain off and are not
24	permitted to be used while in the courtroom. Such devices include mobile
25	phones, laptop computers, and personal digital assistants (PDA's). ¹ Further,
26

(2) Based on security concerns expressed by the Washoe County Sheriff's Office 1 related to the instant case, and pursuant to the Administrative Order entered on 2 June 28, 2007, cameras, recording, reproducing, and transmitting equipment, 3 which are not considered wireless communications devices, are prohibited from 4 the courtroom and courthouse, unless they are associated with the Media and 5 have a pre-approved Media Request permitted under Nevada Supreme Court 6 Rules regarding Electronic Coverage of Court Proceedings. See NSCR 229-246, 7 inclusive. Members of the Media shall abide by all the Nevada Supreme Court 8 Rules regarding Electronic Coverage of Court Proceedings, unless otherwise 9 ordered by the Court. See id. 10 (3) The Jury in this case has been empanelled anonymously. The media shall not be 11 permitted to film the jurors or take still photos of the jurors. See NSCR 238. No 12 other person will be permitted to film or take still photos of the jurors because 13 such individuals will not be permitted to use devices with those capabilities in 14 the courtroom, as provided in the June 28, 2007 Administrative Order. No 15 person shall identify the jurors by anything other than their juror number in the 16 courtroom. If a spectator in the courtroom knows any of the jurors by name or 17 any other identifying factor, such person is prohibited from disseminating that information to any other person. 18 19 (4) There shall be no attempt made to contact any juror in this case regarding any matter connected with this case. There shall be no attempt made to intimidate or 20 harass a witness or juror. 21 (5) There shall be no attempt to talk with or gesture to any witness or juror in the 22 courtroom during proceedings or when they are entering or leaving the 23 courtroom and courthouse facility, except by Counsel with respect to witnesses 24 during the active exercise of his representation in accordance with accepted 25 courtroom practice. 26 (6) There shall be no visual display of approval or disapproval of any witnesses' 27 answers. 28

1	(7) There will be no loud talking, chanting, or other disruptive behavior permitted in
2	the courtroom or the hallway outside the courtroom. Disruptive behavior
3	includes, but is not limited to, sleeping in the courtroom, reading newspapers,
4	magazines or other like material, and children running in aisles.
5	(8) Persons entering the courtroom must dress appropriately for the setting. Persons
6	wearing tank tops, shorts, hats or jogging attire will not be admitted into the
7	courtroom. Shoes and shirts are required in the courtroom at all times.
8	Failure to abide by this Court's orders may constitute contempt of Court and/or
9	a violation of Nevada law. This Court will not hesitate to have anyone who disrupts
	these proceedings by engaging in any of the conduct described above removed from the
10	courtroom and barred from further attendance at this trial.
11	(9) Persons entering the courtroom will not be permitted to occupy any chair in the
12	front row of the gallery. ²
13	This Order is necessary to ensure that the Defendants and the Government have
14	the opportunity to present their case to the jury free from any suggestion of undue
15	outside influence. The Bailiffs and other Courthouse Security Officers who are
16	employed by the Washoe County Sheriff have the authority, without further direction
17	from the Court, to correct improper behavior in the courtroom by removing the
18	offending individual from the proceeding and/ or confiscating a device that is used
19	contrary to this Order. The Washoe County Sheriff shall notify the Court of offending
20	behavior so the Court can take further action if necessary.
21	Based on the forgoing, good cause appearing, and in the interest of justice,
22	IT IS SO ORDERED.
