The Court believes it is unable to entertain the relief sought at this time, and, frankly, the Court is presently unable to meaningfully understand and decipher the relief sought, as will be explained in the Order to be issued. A major problem is that at this time the Court believes it has lost jurisdiction to rule on any and all custody/visitation disputes, as the child at issue is 18, and thus has reached the age of majority. However, if at any time the court determines there are any issues the Court is still able to adjudicate, then as to any future hearings which do occur, this Media Access Order will be fully effective pursuant to Nevada Supreme Court edict.
