I, Alexander Falconi, of Our Nevada Judges, hereby requests permission to broadcast and record the preliminary hearing scheduled in Reno Justice Court docket number RCR2019-103468A, for March 31, 2020, at 1:30 p.m. I hereby certify that I am familiar with the requirement to comply with the Supreme Court Rules 229-446, inclusive.

It is further understood that any media camera pooling arrangements shall be the sole responsibility of the media and must be arranged prior to coverage, without asking for the Court to mediate disputes.

Finally, based on our high court's recent expansion of Nevada case law regarding the public's right to scrutinize attorney conduct, we withdraw voluntary consent to blurring Deputy District Attorney Amos Stege's face. *Abrams v. Sanson*, 136 Nev., Advance Opinion 9 (March 5, 2020) ("The public has an interest in an attorney's courtroom conduct that is not mere curiosity, as it serves as a warning to both potential and current clients looking to hire or retain the lawyer.") We will of course comply with this court's order to do so, should an order be entered, but we would prefer the order be entered over our objection to allow for appellate review. Compare *Solid v. Eighth Judicial District Court*, 113 Nev. 118, 393 P.3d 666 (2017) (considering a challenge under SCR 243 by exercising an exception to the mootness doctrine.)
