



## FOUNDATION GRANTS

Dear Alexander:

The Nevada Bar Foundation had the opportunity to review your application for a 2024 Foundation Grant. Thank you for taking the time to apply and for speaking with one of our trustees about how your organization could put awarded dollars to use.

We have awarded Our Nevada Judges a \$10,000 one-year grant and up to a \$15,000 matching grant to support its Camera Operations. **The offer of matching grant fund support expires on June 30, 2025.**

Should the organization successfully raise additional dollars to support Camera Operations, we will provide a matching grant of up to \$15,000. Please refer to the attached Agreement for Use of Funds for matching grant criteria. This document must be signed and *returned to me before initial grant funding will be released. Matching funds will be released upon proof of successful fundraising for the program you received straight grant funding.*

We ask that you provide a report on how these grant funds were expended no later than **August 1, 2025**. The reporting form can be found [here](#). **Grant dollars may not be used to support other initiatives or programs.** Grant funds not used by the reporting deadline must be returned to the Foundation or a request must be made in writing to the Foundation to carry funds over.

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**AGREEMENT FOR USE OF FUNDS**

It is the Nevada Bar Foundation's (NBF) policy to only make grants to organizations that are exempt from income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) as a public charity under either Code Section 509(a)(1) or (a)(2). According to the information furnished to the NBF with your proposal, your organization is so qualified. ***If at any time there is a change in your tax status, or if your tax status has changed since you submitted your grant proposal, you must notify us in writing.***

The NBF Foundation Grant should only be expended for educational, scientific, literary, or other charitable purposes. Therefore, funds are exclusively to carry out the project described in the application. Also, funds shall not be used to influence legislation, to influence the outcome of any election, or to carry on any voter registration drive.

***Any funds not expended for the purpose for which the grant is being made must be returned to the NBF.***

**MATCHING GRANTS**

If your organization was approved for a matching grant, your agreement signifies acknowledgment of the following (please check boxes and initial):

- Eligible matching dollars must be solicited to support the program outlined in the grant proposal. We request that solicitations specify that the matching grant is provided by the Nevada Bar Foundation.
- Eligible matching dollars must be raised from new donations, not from dollars already pledged to the organization, from in-kind services, or from the organization's operating or cash reserve budget. Documentation that substantiates donations received must be provided before matching funds are released.
- Matching dollars may not be obtained from other grants offered through the Nevada Bar Foundation or the State Bar of Nevada.
- Matching dollars offered are set as a maximum. If the organization is unable to raise matching funds at the amount awarded, the NBF will match the lesser amount raised.

**The NBF offer of matching fund support will expire on June 30, 2025.** Extensions will not be provided; however, the organization is eligible to resubmit an application for the next grant period.

**REPORTING REQUIREMENTS**

By accepting any funding from an NBF Foundation Grant, the organization agrees to provide a report, no later than **August 1, 2025**, detailing how the grant dollars were applied, or the progress of the project if all grant dollars were not spent. The report must be specific to the purpose identified in the approved grant request. If all grant dollars were not used, a written request must be made for funds to be carried over past the reporting deadline or funds must be returned to the Nevada Bar Foundation.
