13 **NOTICE OF DISMISSAL WITHOUT**
14 **PREJUDICE PURSUANT TO**
15 **NRS 174.085(5)**

16 NRS 174.085(5) provides:

17 5. The prosecuting attorney, in a case that he has initiated, may voluntarily dismiss a
18 complaint:

19 (a) Before a preliminary hearing if the crime with which the defendant is
20 charged is a felony or gross misdemeanor; or


21 (b) Before trial if the crime with which the defendant is charged is a
22 misdemeanor, *without prejudice* to the right to file another complaint,
23 unless the State of Nevada has previously filed a complaint against the
24 defendant which was dismissed at the request of the prosecuting
25 attorney. After the dismissal, the court shall order the defendant released
26 from custody or, if he is released on bail, exonerate the obligors and
27 release any bail. (Emphasis added).

28 PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Plaintiff, City of Las Vegas, does hereby voluntarily dismiss
the complaint against the above-captioned Defendant. As this is the first such voluntary dismissal against
the Defendant, this Dismissal shall be without prejudice to the City's right to file another complaint
against the Defendant within the one-year statute of limitations pursuant to NRS 174.085 as applied in
Sheriff, Washoe County v. Marcus, 995 P.2d 1016 (2000).
