11 **ALTERNATIVE WRIT OF MANDAMUS**

12 **AND ORDER TO APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE**

13 Currently before the Court is Petitioners Our Nevada Judges, Inc. ('ONJ') and
14 Alexander Falconi's petition for writ of *mandamus* filed March 13, 2025 and submitted
15 to the Court for consideration.

16 Mr. Falconi alleges attending an appointment at the Department of Motor
17 Vehicles (hereinafter 'DMV'), at 1399 American Pacific Dr., Henderson, NV, and
18 requesting a press plate, which the DMV refused. Mr. Falconi was recognized as
19 running the "press organization" now incorporated as ONJ. *Falconi v. Eighth Judicial*
20 *Dist. Court*, 543 P.3d 92, 94 (2024). See also *Nester vs Eighth Judicial Dist. Ct.*, 141
21 Nev. Adv. Op. 4 (2025). ONJ is thus a member of the press and Mr. Falconi is

1 “engaged” as an “editor”. NRS 482.3672(1). Compare *Toll v. Wilson*, 135, Nev. 430,
2 435, 453 P.3d, 1215, 1219 (2019).

3 ONJ and Falconi have no adequate remedy at law. This Court exercises its
4 discretion to consider the petition. NRS 34.160 and NRS 34.170. Nevada Constitution
5 Article VI Section 6. When the writ is applied for without notice, and the writ is
6 allowed by the Court, an alternative writ shall be first issued. NRS 34.200.

7 Pursuant to NRS 34.200, the Court finds ONJ and Mr. Falconi are a “member
8 of the press” within the definition of NRS 482.3672(1) and orders the DMV to deem
9 Mr. Falconi an “editor” consistent with the law and process Mr. Falconi’s request for a
10 press plate accordingly. In the alternative, the DMV may file an answer to the petition
11 within fourteen (14) days of being served, after which ONJ may file a reply within
12 seven (7) days of being served.

13 Parties are ordered to appear before this Court for a hearing on _____ of
14 April 24, 2025 @ 10:15 a.m., 2025. If the DMV complies with the alternative writ,
15 Parties are ordered to notify this Court so that the hearing can be vacated.
