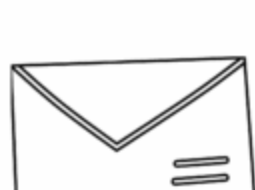

Ballots will be mailed to every registered voter in mid May 2026. If you have not received your mail ballot by May 25, please contact your local elections department.

All mailed in ballots MUST be post marked by Election Day, June 9. Don't wait till the last minute, mail or drop-off your ballot as soon as you get it!
